Minutes: Anderson moved to accept the minutes of the last meeting as read. Christiansen seconded the motion, motion carried.

Financials: Christiansen moved to accept the financial report as written, Anderson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Director's Report: Somerville reported on the few programs we still have. Somerville reported that she and Phil Enright are using the new circulation system and all is going smoothly.
