Long-billed Curlew populations of southwestern Idaho are declining at an alarming rate, placing them on Idaho's "Species of Greatest Conservation Need" list.

Heather Hayes, research biologist and Community Science Coordinator for the Intermountain Bird Observatory (IBO) in Boise, will tell us about these charismatic birds. Learn about their habitats, nesting requirements, and migratory journey as well as how IBO research and satellite technology is uncovering some of the curlew's mysteries and connecting communities across international borders
