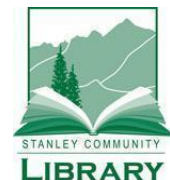


# Stanley Community Library Director's Report for May 13, 2025



## ❖ Staff Accomplishments

## ❖ Program Participation

- April saw 16 programs offered at the Library with a total of 169 attendees.
- There were 8 youth programs for story timers finishing up the alphabet and school kids learning about geology and earthquakes.
- The 8 adult programs highlighted crafting, travel tales, history, fly tying, Sound Healing, book discussions, and games.
- Among the April programs, Library patrons contributed to the "Bird Collisions in the Anthropocene" art project – a large-scale installation of upcycled bird replicas to heighten awareness. Celina Moreno kindly organized and prepped for this program.
- We had our final winter workshops on Fly Tying – much appreciation to Jeff Ballas for organizing and teaching. We also concluded our winter Oral History series with SIHA and wrapped up our book discussions for the season.
